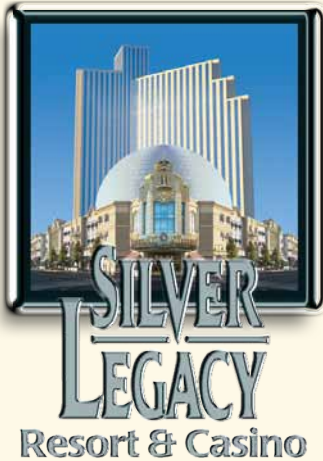

Saturday Workshop

Title vs. Survey - Statutes, Standards and Boundary Law Principles

Providing a professional opinion as to the location of a boundary is a part of the practice of surveying in every state. Boundaries, however, are a function of application of the law and are also inextricably intertwined with matters of title. In this session we will explore matters of survey vs. matters of title, and how surveyors can reconcile the potential conflict of where surveying ends, and title begins. There are many considerations that must be accounted for including recordation laws, the concept of marketable title, title insurance, unwritten title and junior/senior rights, not to mention rules and statutes that regulate the practice of surveying. This program will inform, educate and provoke the audience in this journey through title and boundary surveying.
