

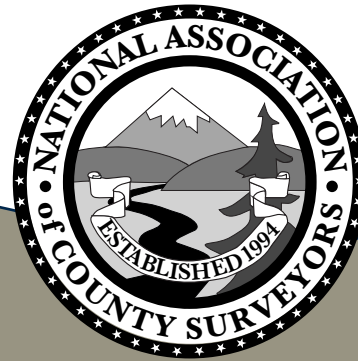


ABOUT NACS
